1. Name: Bucharest MTB Race

3. Format: Cross-Country Olympic (XCO)

4. Categories: Elite Men, Elite Woman, Juniors Men, Juniors Woman


5. Date: 16th of October 2021

7. Course: 5.6 km with 80m of elevation/lap

- The number of laps will be determined according to categories. The start will take place on a 7 m wide road for a distance of 200 m, asphalt flat road. The course features every element of a XCO course- wide road start, off camber sections, wide soil roads, single trail, rock garden, one wood ramp and roots sections.
- Two feed zones, one at the Start and one at approx. the middle of the course.



- 8. Registration is available at the official event website: <a href="www.bucuresti-mtb.ro">www.bucuresti-mtb.ro</a>. Elite athletes are required to present a valid UCI license before picking up the race kit.
- 9. Timing: with chip and live web results
- 10. The Start area will be arranged in the vicinity of Street Splaiul Unirii No. 168, Bucharest.

#### 11.Rules:

- The event is held under Romanian Cycling Federation and Union Cycliste Internationale rules;
- All competitors are required to wear a helmet during competition and training rides;
- Mountain bike is the only type of bicycles allowed;
- Competitors are required to read the event rules and to attend the technical briefing;
- The race number, along with timing chip is to be mounted on the handlebars;
- Competitors are required to sign the waiver and assume the risks associated with competing in this event;
- 12. Technical and medical assistance, feed zones:
  - During the race, technical assistance is limited to component replacement or repair, with the exception of frames;
  - In case of any technical issue, the competitor is required to stop in the technical zone;
  - Technical assistance is offered on the course and in the start/finish area;
  - Feeding/hydration zones will be available for participants;



- 13. Disqualification occurs in any of the following situations:
  - Taking shortcuts or not completing the entire course;
  - Non sporting behavior, lack of respect towards competitors, spectators or organizers;
  - Getting help from people outside the event;
  - Alcohol or performance enhancing substance consumption;
  - Disregard of competition rules or instructions from race commissaries and organizer's location;
